START YOUR BUSINESS CHECKLIST

- 1. Decide on a name for your business.
- 2. Register your business in the province in which you and your business are located.
- 3. Set up a separate business bank account.
- 4. Set up a credit card for your business.
- 5. Determine if you need to register for sales tax.
- 6. Evaluate if the Quick Method of calculating sales tax is more beneficial.
- 7. Register for HST/GST with CRA* or if in Quebec, HST/GST and QST with RQ**, if required.
- 8. Register for a payroll number with CRA* and if located in Quebec RQ**, if you plan to hire employees.
- 9. Register for CRA* My Business Account or RQ** My Business Account, if located in Quebec.
- 10. Evaluate what type of accounting system you are going to use e.g. spreadsheet, accounting software, or outsource.
- 11. Decide how you plan to do your income taxes DIY using software or outsource.
